6. At the conclusion of the project, grant awardees are requested to submit a project summary including photos and receipts for purchases.

Project ideas include, but are not limited to:

- School or community garden with cool weather, spring and fall crops
- Composting food scraps and yard waste
- Tree planting
- Planting pollinator gardens
- Houseplants propagation and for public sale
- Starting seedlings and selling or donating for summer vegetable gardens
- Educational trip to a botanical garden or arboretum
- Student-led effort to partner with organization to identify and label plants at a local park to help educate public
- Invasive plant species identification and removal
